

Example Lesson Plans

One of the challenges of teaching International Understanding is creating fun and interesting lessons that motivate students to learn about the world and its languages. To give teachers ideas for structuring these types of lessons, *Teachers & Kids* provides examples of English, Cultural, and ALT Introduction lesson plans for each grade level. The following is a 6th year example lesson plan for the cultural topic, The World.

Topic: The World

Phrase: **Do you know ___? : **Yes / Yes, I do
**No / No, I don't

(Warm-up)

1. (8min)
 - Greeting => The teacher says, "Hello" and "Good Morning / Good Afternoon", the students repeat.
 - Review "Where are you from?" : "I'm from (country name)."
 - One Minute Limit (2) => Practice "Where are you from?" : "I'm from ____."

(Lesson)

2. (10min)
 - Flag Puzzles (52)
3. (3min)
 - Review all the flag names and the locations of their countries. (Say names in both English & Japanese)
4. (2min)
 - Explain "Do you know (country name)?" and "Yes / Yes, I do / No / No, I don't"
(any of these answers is ok.)
5. (10min)
 - Banana Game (46) => Using "Do you know (country name)?"
6. (7min)
 - Ask the students what countries they want to go to and answer any questions about the world.
